

The following motion was approved by electronic vote on November 20, 2022. This electronic vote is consistent with Prospect Park Association's (PPA) new bylaws, approved 8-22-22 (see "Written Action Without a Meeting").

Proposed Motion: Add Prospect Park Association to SECIA's letter requesting the Mayor and Minneapolis City Council increase neighborhood organization "base funding" from \$10,000 to \$25,000 in order "to support the long-term viability of our neighborhood organizations and ensure the successful achievement of Neighborhoods 2020 program goals." SECIA's letter in full was attached to the email you received.

Background: PPA's Board of Directors has approved similar motions in the past. In fact, the City increased neighborhood organization "base funding" by \$5,000 each year in 2021 & 2022. If the City does not increase base funding for 2023 during the City of Minneapolis 2023 budget process, our base funding will decrease by \$10,000 to only \$10,000.
